Toledo Jeep Fest Base Camp Information



Overlanding sites are 15' x 30' and can accommodate groups of up to 8 guests and one additional vehicle



Access to Rotary Roundhouse shelter with picnic tables and restroom facilities



Bring your dog and utilize Middlegrounds off-leash area



Metroparks will provide several common fire pits and will provide fire wood



Enjoy Middlegrounds 1.5 mile walk/bike path along the Maumee River



Bring your kayaks and utilize the Kayak Cove launch area

Toledo Jeep Fest Base Camp is conveniently located less than a mile from the Vendor Midway, Glass City Center, Promenade Park, Fifth Third Field and the start of the All-Jeep Parade route.
