Based out of Flint Bishop International Airport and captivating audiences since 1992, the War Birds preserve the history of American military aviation through educational and commemorative flight demonstrations featuring beautifully restored historic aircrafts.

Watch as these iconic aircrafts soar overhead in a powerful four-pass flyover featuring:

- » **Vultee BT-13** (one of only two still flying in the United States)
- » **North American AT-6 Texan** (trainer of the legendary Tuskegee Airmen "Red Tails")
- » **Two T-34 Mentor aircraft**



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We honor America's 250th Anniversary with a celebration of courage, sacrifice, freedom, and aviation history.
